The band would like to take this opportunity to thank the venue team and we look forward to working with you. Please find some information below that will hopefully be useful.

Sound

The band do not carry PA or desk. As such they would require use of the venue equipment to a comparable spec, plus a competent, sober and focused house sound engineer. Engineers must be fully proficient in the desk being used.

The singer requires both his main mic/ FX channels, and in-ear monitor sends in stereo where possible please.

Power

Please supply 13a UK mains power drops upstage per band member, plus three extra downstage for pedals (see stage plot), plus one at the FoH control position.

It will help speed things up if these power drops are ready on our arrival.

Lighting

The band do not have their own lighting engineer.

Creativity and drama is encouraged, but please ensure the band remain lit from the front throughout the show and that there is still some light on stage between songs. The band love haze and/ or blasts of smoke at appropriate moments but please don't overdo it.

Visuals

If the venue has a projector and screen, or other professional means of displaying visuals behind the band, then we have a slideshow and some other visuals on USB drive.
